#### **Ouick Updates**

ISWS data project update – We have data from IEPA. Mike Machesky is retiring. We're expecting Laura Keefer (will be taking Mike's place. Expect some delays because of the change of staff. Discussion was had regarding the Database that was supposed to be ready by mid-July.

#### **USGS Probe Update**

USGS reported there have been no issues this year and they have "good data". The data is available at Illinois.water.usgs.gov

#### **IDNR Dam Removal Project**

The Carpentersville Dam Removal project is still moving forward. IDNR has submitted a contract renewal to "Legal", which eventually needs to go to the Governors' office for approval. The North Aurora Dam Removal project contract has expired.

# **Army Corps Fox River Habitat & Connectivity Study Update**

The Study is still in discussion with management. They "appear" agreeable to sharing costs. If the FRSG were to share costs, their portion would be approximately \$209,000.00 out of the \$597,000.00 total cost. The FRSG has yet to receive any kind of breakdown of cost from Army Corps and cannot make a commitment without this breakdown.

Permit Conditions for renewed NPDES permits – Al Keller

All "Majors" will be required to include .5 mg/L and .1 mg/L P in their Feasibility Studies. Much discussion was had regarding Monthly Averages vs. Annual Averages, Monthly and Daily Maximums. It was stated the USEPA will be "looking at Monthly Averages. 60 Permits are on hold based on comments from environmental groups. More discussion was had regarding MWRD's settlement of a geometric mean of 0.5 mg/L P to be met by 2030.
